



## Getting Started with Atomz 5.0

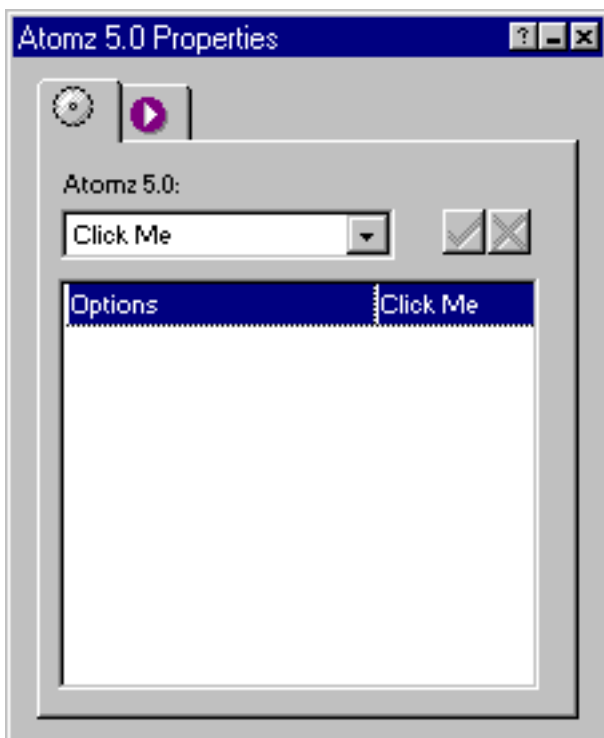
Atomz 5.0 is a NetObjects Fusion v4/5 compatible component that allows you to easily configure and place an Atomz Search box on your page, based on your Atomz account.

Atomz 5.0 is free to all users of Netobjects Fusion, enjoy!

Getting started with Atomz 5.0 is easy!

- Run the Installation program, specifying the location of Fusion v4.0/5.0's component directory.
- Launch Fusion v4.0/5.0
- If the coolmaps.com component toolbar is not visible choose View > Toolbars > Component Tools > coolmaps.com basic
- Select the Atomz component and drag out an area on the page. By default a REAL Full Control graphic appears on the page.

Atomz Properties now appear in Fusion's Properties palette.



Atomz is a java window component. Click on 'Click Me' in the Properties palette to

open the Atomz window shown below:

### Usage Notes

To make use of the Coolmaps Atomz 5.0 component you must first sign up for the [Atomz Search](#) service and have at least one active Atomz URL.

With your Atomz account configured, place the Coolmaps Atomz component on the page. A Placeholder graphic appears - this will be where your Atomz search box will be generated.

Click 'Click Me' in the properties palette to open the Atomz java window. There may be a delay the first time you do this.



Enter your Atomz account email and password. The Atomz component will then log into the Atomz server and return your list of Atomz accounts.

NOTE : You must be online for the Atomz component to function.



Having logged in successfully to your Atomz account select the account you'd like to create a search box for from the Dropdown. Check the Advanced search box if applicable. Click OK when you're done.

On publishing your site the Atomz search box will be generated according to the options you've chosen in the java window.
