Getting Started with EinSteinium

EinSteinium (99) is no longer just a periodic element with no commercial use! It's now a calculator component for NetObjects Fusion!

Run the Installation program, specifying the location of Fusion 4.0's component directory.

- Launch Fusion
- If the coolmaps.com component toolbar is not visible choose View > Toolbars > Component Tools > coolmaps.com components
- Select the EinSteinium component and drag out an area on the page (this graphic does not appear on the published page).

The EinSteinium properties now appear in Fusion's properties palette.



EinStein Options

The following options are found on the EinStein properties palette:

Type of Calc

- Basic - Add, Subtract, Multiply, and Divide.
- Scientific - Adds trigonometric functions, square, square root, etc.

Table Borders - Choose between borders or no borders.

Note : The size Form elements appear varies with each browser. Check your EinStein in different browsers to be sure it fits in your popup and/or does not disrupt the page layout.
