## Getting Started with FrameSet

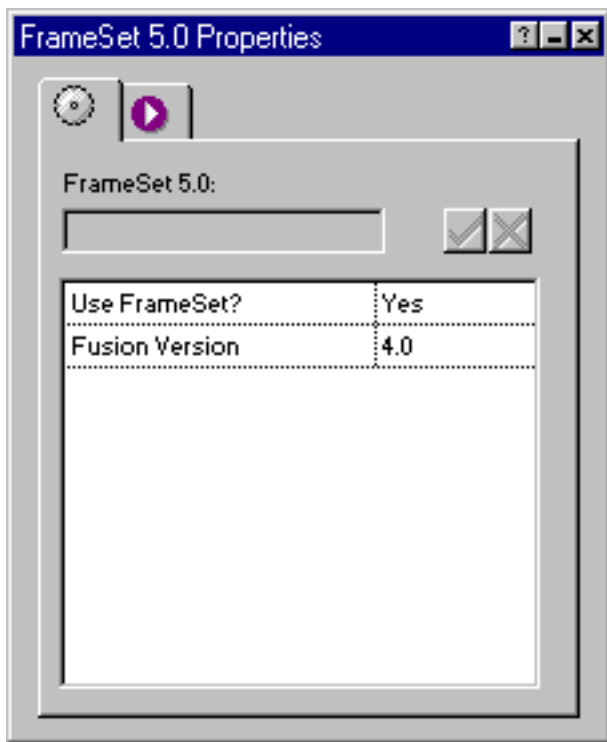
Don't let your site get caught! FrameSet 4.0/5.0 stops your site from being loaded into somebody else's FrameSet, an unfortunate practice which is now common-place on the web.

With FrameSet your site will always be displayed in a full browser window - as you intended!

- Run the Installation program, specifying the location of Fusion 4.0/5.0's component directory.
- Launch Fusion
- If the coolmaps.com component toolbar is not visible choose  
View > Toolbars > Component Tools  
> coolmaps.com components
- Select the FrameSet component and drag out an area on the page (this graphic does not appear on the published page)

The FrameSet properties now appears in Fusion's properties palette.



### FrameSet Options

Use FrameSet (yes/no)

Toggle allows you to place FrameSet on the page and activate/de-activate it from the Properties Palette.

Fusion Version (4.0/5.0)

Due to changes in Fusion's API between v4 and v5, there are two versions of FrameSet, both available within the one FrameSet component. Be sure to select the correct version (the one you are using the component in) from the dropdown in the Properties Palette.

Usage Tips

Place FrameSet in the Layout Region of a page to have it applied to only that page.

Place FrameSet in the Masterborder Region of a page to have it applied to all pages that use that MasterBorder.
