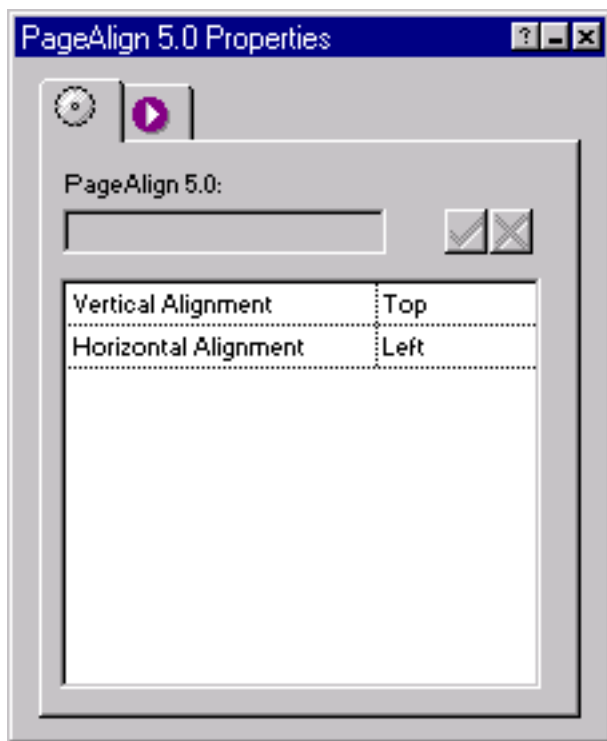
Getting Started with PageAlign

PageAlign allows you to effortlessly configure the in-browser alignment of your web pages.

Getting started with PageAlign is easy!

- Run the Installation program, specifying the location of Fusion v4/5/MX's component directory.
- Launch Fusion v4/5/MX.
- If the coolmaps.com component toolbar is not visible choose View > Toolbars > Component Tools > coolmaps basic
- Select the PageAlign component and drag it on your page.

The PageAlign Properties now appear in Fusion's properties palette.



PageAlign Options

Vertical Alignment - Top | Middle | Bottom
Select the vertical alignment for the page.

Horizontal Alignment - Left | Center | Right

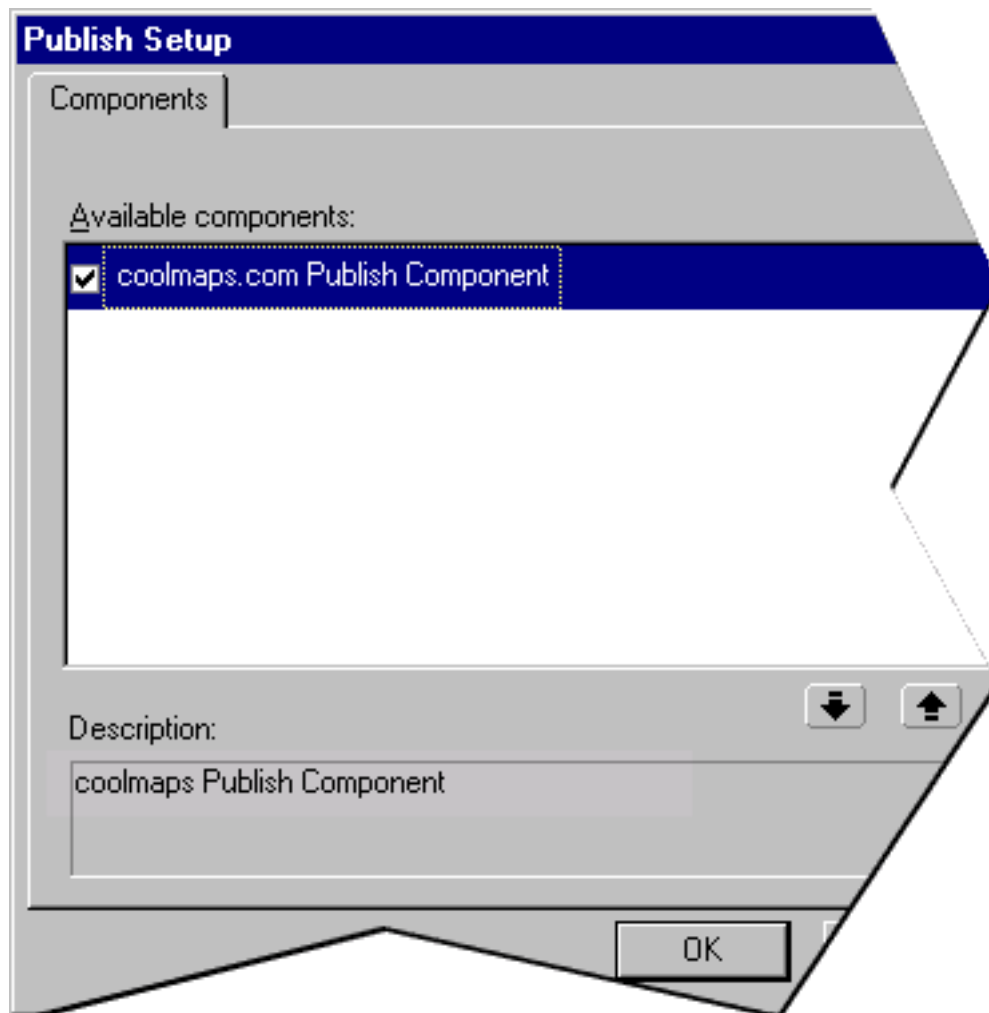
Select the horizontal alignment for the page.

Usage Notes:

- PageAlign can be placed in the MasterBorder to affect all pages that share that MasterBorder.
- PageAlign is compatible with just about every web browser. However, if the page is published using Fixed Page Layout (CSSP+Layers) or has Actions, compatibility will drop to just 4.0+ browsers. This is due to PageAlign accomodating those technologies which are only 4.0+ compatible. All unsupported web browsers will display the page in the upper left corner (no harm done).

Once the palette options are configured, the coolmaps.com Publish Component must be enabled.

- Choose Publish View > Publish > Publish Components
- Check 'coolmaps.com Publish Component'
