## v5.0 Component Upgrades Issues

Components information on this page refers to PopRocket, CodeTweaker, FreeStyle, LineOne, SiteSearch, SiteReporter, RemoteControl and OnHold.

### PopRocket 4.\*

To improve the performance of PopRocket the java options window has been removed. All PopRocket options now appear in Fusion's Properties palette.

If PopRocket v5.0 does not function (in a migrated Fusion v4.\* site) when the site is published go to Page View in Fusion and re-enter the 'name' into the "Name" field in the properties palette.

### CodeTweaker \*.\*

Fusion's templates (.nft) do not automatically include CodeTweaker's files. You will need to move the "tweaker.txt" "include.txt" "exclude.txt" to the directory containing the new nod file.

### FreeStyle 4.0 & LineOne 4.0

Fusion v5.0's CSS support absorbs coolmaps FreeStyle component. Similarly, the new HTML Source View absorbs LineOne. Both components will remain available for Fusion v4.0 but will not be upgraded to v5.0 components. Tomorrow's Fusion Today!

If you use either FreeStyle or LineOne in your sites please remove them prior to migrating your v4.\* site.

### SiteSearch 4.0

SiteSearch is currently not available for sale. A more robust SiteSearch is under development. Existing SiteSearch customers can download a v5.0 compatible version. SiteSearch customers please contact the [ClubMaster](#) if you have any questions.

### SiteReporter

SiteReporter is currently not available as a v5.0 Component. If you have SiteReporter active in a v4.\* site, please disable SiteReporter in Publish View prior to migrating your site to Fusion v5.0. SiteReporter v5.0 will be available Jan/Feb.

### RemoteControl

Due to changes in Fusion v5.0, RemoteControl is now available in two versions - v4.0 and v5.0. The corresponding version must be used - e.g. v4 in v4, v5 in v5.

RemoteControl v4.0 and v5.0 are available as an individual downloads from your my.components page. RemoteControl v5.0 is also included in the GoldMine download.

RemoteControl v5.0 currently has several features disabled that are in the process of being completed.

### OnHold 4.0

OnHold is a free novelty component that plays a selected midi file while Fusion generates your site. OnHold has not been upgraded to v5.0 status. OnHold does function in Fusion v5.0 and has been included in the GoldMine Install.

If you use OnHold in your v4.\* site and will not be installing it in v5.0 uncheck the component prior to migrating your v4.\* site.

## Migrating your Fusion v4.\* Site to v5.0

Do you have a Fusion v4.\* site that uses Coolmaps v4.\* Components? Follow the steps below for a smooth transition into v5.0.

1. With your site open in Fusion v4.0 go to Site View and Choose File > Export as Template.

Exporting your site as a template gathers up a copy of all the assets related to your site and places them with the site template (.nft). Your v4.\* site is now easy to transport to a new location if need be.

As important, exporting your site as a template helps to 'clean' your .nod file, a worthwhile process prior to migrating your site to a new version of Fusion.

NOTE : If you use CodeTweaker you will need to move the Tweaker.txt, Include.txt and Exclude.txt files manually with your Template as Fusion does not include these in the .nft file.

Alternatively you may choose to leave your site as a .nod file. When you open it in Fusion you will be asked if you'd like to 'Open a Copy' - choose Yes to preserve your original site file.

2. Install Fusion v5.0 on your system

3. Download your free Coolmaps v5.0 Component Upgrades and install them. Be sure to install all the equivalent v5.0 components you have in use in your v4.\* sites.

**DO NOT INSTALL V4.\* COMPONENTS IN FUSION V5.0.**

NOTE : If you have not installed Fusion in its default location be sure to check the Install Path for the Components.

4. Launch Fusion v5.0.

If you have exported a Template of your v4.\* site from any View in Fusion v5.0 choose File > New Site > From Template. Browse to your Template, Choose a Name and Location for your new v5 .nod file.

If you did not export a Template, from any View in Fusion v5.0 choose File > Open Site. Browse to your v4.\* .nod file. Fusion will prompt you to open a copy of the site rather than the original v4.\* file. We **STRONGLY** recommend opening a copy of the site and preserving your v4.\* nod file as a back up.

5. Go to Page View. Select your Coolmaps components one by one - the components properties are available for editing in Fusion's Properties Palette.

If your Coolmaps Components are not visible choose View > Toolbars > Component Tools > Coolmaps.com Components.

NOTE : Coolmaps v5.0 Components are compatible with both Fusion v5.0 and Fusion v4.\* However, do NOT install v5.0 Components over existing Fusion v4.\* components that are in use in Fusion v4.\*.

For example, if you have TextTree v4.\* installed in Fusion v4.\* and in use on sites do not install TextTree v5.0 over it. If however you do not have TextTree v4.\* installed or in use on v4 sites, TextTree v5.0 can be installed in Fusion v4.

## v5.0 Component Upgrades - Do's and Don'ts

Coolmaps v5.0 Components are compatible with both Fusion v5.0 and Fusion v4.\* However, do NOT install v5.0 Components over existing Fusion v4.\* components that are in use in Fusion v4.\*.

For example, if you have TextTree v4.\* installed in Fusion v4.\* and in use on sites do not install TextTree v5.0 over it. If however you do not have TextTree v4.\* installed or in use on v4 sites, TextTree v5.0 can be installed in Fusion v4.

---

Do NOT install v4.\* components in Fusion v5.0. All Coolmaps customers receive a free upgrade to v5.0 components, available from the [my.components](#) page.

---

Please check and install all v5.0 components that are in use in your v4.\* sites PRIOR to opening the v4.\* site in Fusion v5.0.

---

Disable or remove any v4.\* components in your Fusion v4.\* site that are no longer needed or available PRIOR to opening your site in Fusion v5.0.

---

Back up your v4.\* site .nod file PRIOR to opening your site in Fusion v5.0, or choose the 'Open a Copy' option. Your original .nod file is your insurance should problems occur, preserve it!

---
